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ANTIRAGGING CELL

An **Anti-Ragging Cell** is a committee or group established within educational institutions, especially universities and colleges, to prevent and address ragging (a form of bullying or harassment) among students. Key Functions of an Anti-Ragging Cell:

- 1. Awareness Programs:**

- 2. Complaint Mechanism:**
 - Provide students with a confidential platform or helpline to report incidents of ragging.
 - Ensure that all complaints are investigated thoroughly and impartially.
- 3. Preventive Measures:**
 - Implement strict regulations and guidelines to discourage ragging activities.
 - Monitor and supervise the behavior of senior students towards freshers.
- 4. Disciplinary Action:**
 - In case ragging occurs, the Anti-Ragging Cell can take necessary disciplinary actions, such as warnings, suspension, or expulsion, depending on the severity of the incident.
- 5. Support and Counseling:**
 - Offer counseling services for students affected by ragging to help them cope with emotional distress.

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- Provide support for both victims and the accused to ensure that the issue is resolved without further escalation.

6. Collaboration with Authorities:

- Work with local law enforcement, and legal authorities, and involve parents if necessary to ensure the safety and well-being of students.
