- Monitor and supervise the behavior of senior students towards freshers.

4. Disciplinary Action:

o In case ragging occurs, the Anti-Ragging Cell can take necessary disciplinary actions, such as warnings, suspension, or expulsion, depending on the severity of the incident.

5. Support and Counseling:

 Offer counseling services for students affected by ragging to help them cope with emotional distress.
